53% of seniors working post-retirement do so for additional income.



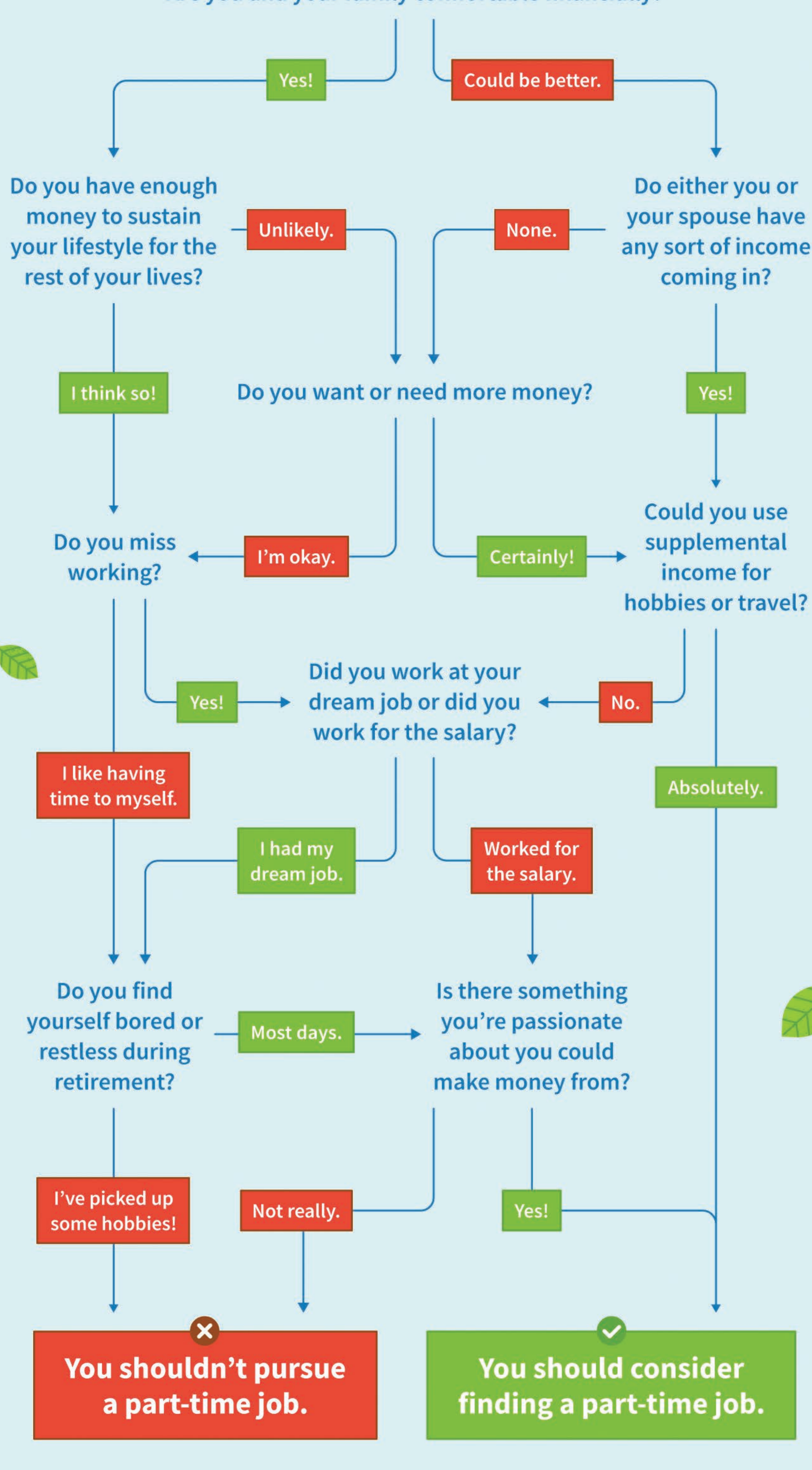
40% of workers aged 55+ were working or actively looking for work.

The Highest-Paying Part-Time Jobs for Retirees

1 Consultant

Requirements: Previous experience as a proven expert

Average hourly pay: \$40

2 Landscaper

Requirements: Previous experience

Average hourly pay: \$33.35

Best for: Seniors who want to help cultivate an outdoor oasis to relax in.

3 House Sitter

Requirements: None

Average hourly pay: \$33

Best for: Retirees that want a more flexible position they can do on their own terms.



4 HR Coordinator

Requirements: Previous experience, degree in relevant field

Average hourly pay: \$29.77

Best for: Seniors that want to work remotely while still helping a company succeed.

5 Adjunct College Instructor

Requirements: Proven expert in field

Average hourly pay: \$27

Best for: Seniors looking to teach and inspire the next generation.
